The plan to organize an international collegium Neuro-Psychopharmacologicum was made in May 1957 during a meeting in Milano.

In September 1957, during the 2. International Congress of Psychiatry in Zürich, the **Collegium Internationale Neuro-Psychopharmacologicum (CINP)** was officially founded by a group of psychopharmacologists. The first congress was held 1958 in Rome.

Since then, every two years the CINP-congress takes place with continuously growing success, regarding the increasing number of participants from a small group of active researchers, sometimes to more than 6000 basic and clinical researchers, clinicians, practitioners, and students from diverse fields such as psychiatry, psychology, pharmacology, neurology etc. from countries all over the world. This reflects the enormous progress in psychopharmacology from chlorpromazine, imipramine and lithium to the atypical antipsychotics, selective antidepressants and mood-stabilizers.

The CINP congress was held three times in Munich under the organizing responsibility of the department of Psychiatry of the Ludwig-Maximilians-University: 1962, 1988, and 2008.

The history of the CINP with special emphasis on the Munich congresses will be demonstrated in this exhibition.
