The Lilly Neuroscience Basic Research Award will be presented at the XXVIth CINP Congress in Munich. The recipient of the 2008 award will be chosen by an international scientific jury by the beginning of March 2008. This award consists of a monetary award, an engraved plaque, paid registration fees for the Congress, round trip economy air travel, and up to five nights accommodation at a Congress Hotel.

Guidelines:

- The Lilly Neuroscience Basic Research Award is given to a scientist in recognition of an outstanding contribution to psychopharmacology.
- Candidates must be less than 55 years of age as of 1st January 2008.
- Candidates must be nominated by a member of the CINP. The nominee should be affiliated with a Hospital, University, or Research Institution.
- The Awardee must commit to attendance at the 2008 Congress for at least three full days.

To submit a nomination, the following application materials must be submitted by email or by hard copy in English, by the 6th February 2008 deadline:

- 1) This completed form.
- 2) No more than five (5) published articles representing the work accomplished.
- 3) A summary not exceeding four (4) double-spaced typed pages explaining the significance of the contribution.
- 4) A letter of nomination from a CINP member.
- 5) An up-to-date curriculum vitae including a list of publications.
