



THE DR. PAUL JANSSEN SCHIZOPHRENIA RESEARCH AWARD

COLLEGIUM INTERNATIONALE NEURO-PSYCHOPHARMALOGICUM

The Dr. Paul Janssen Schizophrenia Research Award will be presented at the XXVth CINP Congress in Munich. The recipient of the 2008 award will be chosen by an international scientific jury by the beginning of March 2008. A monetary award and engraved plaque, paid registration fees for the Congress, round trip economy air travel, and up to five nights accommodation at a Congress Hotel.

Guidelines:

- The Dr. Paul Janssen Schizophrenia Research Award is given to a young investigator who has performed outstanding research in the field of Basic or Clinical Neuroscience of Schizophrenia at a University, Institute, or any other acknowledged scientific institution. This research must be independent and not supported by the pharmaceutical industry.
- Candidates must be less than 45 years of age on 1st January 2008.
- The Dr. Paul Janssen Schizophrenia Research Award is open to individuals world-wide, independent of nationality, sex or race.
- The submitted work should, at least in part, be the result of investigations conducted by the candidate during the five years preceding the year of the award.

The Awardee must commit to attendance at the 2008 Congress for at least three full days.

To submit a nomination, the following application materials must be submitted by email or by hard copy in English, by the 6th February 2008 deadline:

- 1) The completed application form.
- 2) A memorandum substantiating the importance of study(ies) in no more than 2000 words.
- 3) 3-5 examples of recent most important papers and manuscripts (in press or submitted) relating to the research.
- 4) General title of research programme.
- 5) An up-to-date curriculum vitae including a list of publications.
